The letters A - Z are used to form words. Words help us to understand meanings. Sometimes the letters in a word are jumbled. So, we have to arrange them properly to form a meaningful word.

Example:

NAMOG



MANGO

“NAMOG” is not a word, but “MANGO” would be the correct answer as it is a meaningful word.

MURELLAB



UMBRELLA

“MURELLAB” is not a word, but “UMBRELLA” would be the correct answer as it is a meaningful word.

SEHOU



HOUSE

“SEHOU” is not a word, but “HOUSE” would be the correct answer as it is a meaningful word.

WRELOF



FLOWER

“WRELOF” is not a word, but “FLOWER” would be the correct answer as it is a meaningful word.

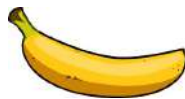

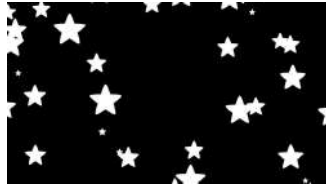
