Chapter 1

Analogy

In the dictionary, analogy means a comparison between two things that shows a way in which they are similar.

Sometimes the things being compared are quite similar, but in some cases, they could be very different. Nevertheless, an analogy explains one thing in terms of another to highlight how they are alike.

In logical reasoning as well, students have to do the same thing. One example will be given to the students and they will have to identify the logic or the relationship between the two given entities. Following that they can apply the same relationship or logic to the given question. It will be better understood with the help of few examples.

Example 1:



: Night ::



: ?

- a. Summer
- c. Morning

- b. Sun
- d. Winter

Solution 1: c

Try to figure out what is similar between Night and the Moon in the image, Moon is seen in Night.

This logic can be applied to the real question which asks us to relate the sun in the image with any of the given options.

Hence, Morning will be the correct answer.

Let's have a look at one more example:

Example 2: B : 2 :: E : ?

- a. 3
- c. 2

Solution 2: b

We will first try to relate B with 2.

We know that the place value of B is 2. (Kindly refer to the table for reference)

Therefore, we will search for the place value of E.

Hence, the answer is 5.

Now, we will go through a number related analogy question:

Example 3: $12 : 10 :: 16 : ?$

Solution 3: a

In this question, try to establish a relation between 12 and 10. How much should be reduced from 12 to obtain 10?

The answer is 2.

So, try to apply the same logic in the other part of the question.

Reduce 2 from 16 and you will get your correct answer.

Therefore, $16 - 2 = 14$.

Hence, 14 is the answer.
