Yellowstone National Park is spread over the states of Wyoming, Idaho, and Montana in the USA. It became the first National Park in 1872. There are geysers, hot springs and animals at Yellowstone. Some of the animals are elk. bison, sheep, grizzly bears, black bears, moose, and coyotes. More than 3 million people visit Yellowstone National Park each year. During the winter, visitors can ski or go snowmobiling there. There are also snow coaches that give tours. Visitors can see steam (vapour water) coming out from the geysers. During other seasons, visitors can go boating or fishing. People can even ride horses. There are nature trails and tours. Most visitors want to see Old Faithful, a very predictable geyser at Yellowstone. Visitors can check the schedule to see the exact time when the Old Faithful geyser will erupt. There are many other geysers and boiling springs in the area. Great Fountain Geyser erupts every eleven hours. Excelsior Geyser produces 4,000 gallons of boiling water each minute! Boiling water is 100 degrees Celsius, or 212 degrees Fahrenheit – that's very hot! People also like to see the Grand Prismatic Spring. It is the largest hot spring in the park. It has many beautiful colours. The beautiful colours occur due to bacteria in the water. These are forms of life that have only one cell. Different bacteria live in different water

temperatures. Visiting Yellowstone National Park can be a week-long vacation or more. It is a beautiful park with many activities for everyone.
